Go ve therefore, and teach all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Chost, Teaching them to observe things whatsover I have commanded you. And, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the World, Matt. 28:19.

Hence the command to the Christian is "go", and the command to the sinner is :'come'-Matt. 11:28 30.
