<u>Alleged Bible Contradictions - Temptation</u>

Allegedly, there is a contradiction between what James wrote about temptation and what Moses recorded about Abraham. Genesis 22:1 reads, "And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham." James wrote, "Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth He any man" (Jas. 1:13). What is going on in these two passages?

While the word *tempt* appears in the KJV of Genesis 22:1, the NKJV correctly used the term stating that God *tested* Abraham's faith. The same Hebrew word is used in 1 Samuel 17:39 stating that David had not "*tested*" Saul's armor before he went to fight with Goliath. God, in instructing Abraham to offer Isaac, was giving Abraham the opportunity to prove his faith – He was not enticing him to sin. The Hebrews writer touched on what happened with this sacrifice when he wrote, "*By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son*" (Heb. 11:17-19). In Abraham's mind, when God commanded it, it was done! That is the type of faith God's people today need!

In the first chapter of James there are two forms of testing that are spoken of. There are *trials* that come from external sources (1:2-8) and *temptations* that come from internal desires (1:13-16). The enticement to commit sin comes when one is "*drawn away of his own lusts and enticed*" (1:14). Sin originates in the heart of man and comes to fruition when the thought is acted upon (Mk. 7:18-23). James also wrote, "*Do not err, my beloved brethren*" (1:16). In other words, don't misunderstand the origin and consequences of temptation and sin in your lives – it does not come from God! James goes even further by saying, "*Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights*" (1:17). The Greek states that good things continually are coming down from the Father.

In their efforts to discredit and demean God, atheists actually show their ignorance of Him and His nature. Instead of digging in and studying words, they dig in and misrepresent what Scripture records for us. After Abraham submitted himself to God's will, the angel of the Lord said, "now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from Me" (Gen. 22:12). Abraham's faithful obedience to God led to him being referred to as "the friend of God" (Jas. 2:23). When the Christian today submits himself to the will of God, he becomes God's friend. When he resists the temptation to sin he draws closer to God and God to him (Jas. 4:7-8).
